In spite of a difficult job market and unpredictable economy, no reported full time offers to LER graduates were lost due to COVID.

Student Profile

In 2019-20, LER master's students came from 76 undergraduate institutions (37 domestic and 39 international), 61 majors, 13 states, and nine countries.

The class is 75% female, 31.7% minority (20.1% African American, Latino and Native American; 11.6% Asian American). The class is 30% international. Thirty-one percent have at least one year work experience and the average age is 23.

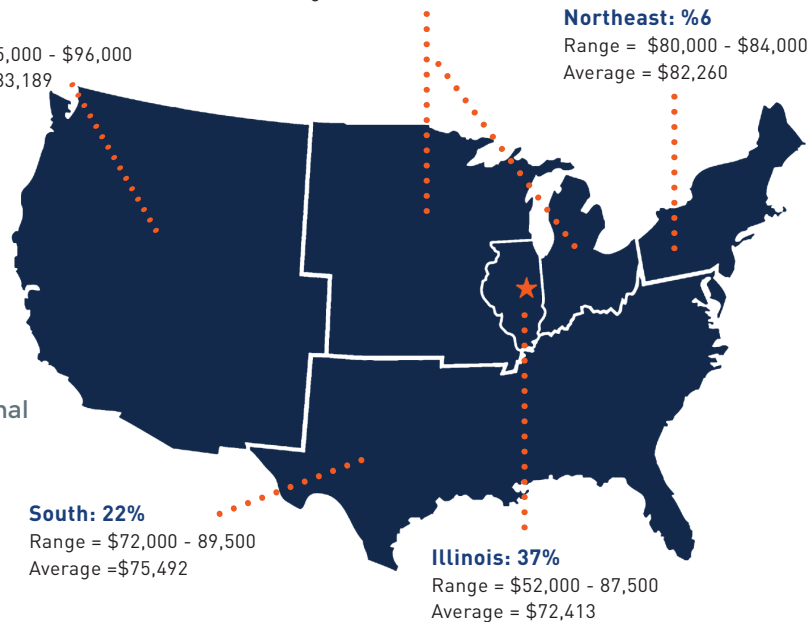

Internships

This year, 15% of accepted internships were lost due to COVID, and many searches were suspended due to lack of hiring.

LER partnered with seven organizations to create eight consulting projects for credit that gave 29 students a meaningful summer opportunity. These students included international students unable to return to their home country, students waiting to hear the fate of their planned internship, and students who were unable to secure an internship due to the suspension of hiring.
