[University housing](#) for graduate students is available in the form of on-campus graduate student residence halls and apartments, all of which are located near convenient transportation and academic buildings. [Private Certified Housing](#) is certified by the University of Illinois for all students, including freshmen. These facilities are part of the University's housing program. They offer an array of comfortable and attractive living accommodations in a wide range of prices and sizes.

Students seeking privately owned housing are urged to visit the campus as early as possible, because arrangements for this type of accommodation usually are made in person. Your assigned LER Buddy might also be a great resource or may be seeking a roommate for the upcoming semester too. TRANSPORTATION and CAMPUS PARKING

Airports

[Willard Airport](#) | Savoy, IL

Champaign-Urbana's local airport (CMI) is served by [American Airlines](#) which links to major hubs in Dallas and Chicago where passengers can make connections to destinations worldwide. Willard Airport is only **five miles south of Champaign**. The easiest form of transportation to campus is the MTD Air Bus. Other ground transportation options include taxi service or onsite car rental available from [Avis](#), [Budget](#), [Hertz](#), and [National](#).

There are five other major airports **within a 200-mile radius of Champaign Urbana.**

[Central Illinois Regional Airport](#) | Bloomington-Normal, IL

A few [airline carriers](#) serve Bloomington-Normal. Located **50 miles from Champaign-Urbana**, onsite car rental is available from [Alamo](#), [Avis](#), [Budget](#), [Hertz](#), and [National](#). [Illini Express](#) and [Peoria Charter](#) bus services run from the airport to Champaign-Urbana.

[Chicago O'Hare Airport](#) | Chicago, IL

Many [carriers](#) serve O'Hare International Airport. Located **150 miles from Champaign-Urbana**, onsite [car rental](#) is available. [Illini Shuttle](#), [Peoria Charter](#), and [Illini Express](#) bus services run from the airport to Champaign-Urbana. You can take also a cab to Union Station in Chicago and catch the [Amtrak](#) train to the Champaign Terminal, but this is a bit inconvenient especially if you have sizeable luggage.

[Chicago Midway Airport](#) | Chicago, IL

Common [airline carriers](#) serve Midway. Located **130 miles from Champaign-Urbana**, onsite [car rental](#) is available. [Illini Shuttle](#), [Peoria Charter](#), and [Illini Express](#) bus services run from the airport to Champaign-Urbana. You can take also a cab to Union Station in Chicago and catch the [Amtrak](#) train to the Champaign Terminal, but this is a bit inconvenient especially if you have sizeable luggage.

[Indianapolis International](#)* | Indianapolis, IN

Several [airline carriers](#) serve Indianapolis International Airport. Located **125 miles from Champaign-Urbana**, ground transportation includes onsite [car rental](#). [Illini Express](#) bus services run from the airport to Champaign-Urbana.

*** Indiana is on Eastern Standard Time (EST) which is one hour ahead of Champaign-Urbana, which is on Central Standard Time (CST), so plan accordingly!!**

[Lambert - St. Louis International Airport](#) | St. Louis, MO

Many [airline carriers](#) serve Lambert. Located **190 miles from Champaign-Urbana**, ground transportation options are [Greyhound](#) bus service (800-231-2222) or onsite [car rental](#) is available.

NOTE: For rental cars, you are required to have a Driver's License, a major credit card in your name, and you must be 21 years of age or older.
