


Graduates

Domestic graduates accepted full-time positions in 44 cities across 21 states.

Fifty-six percent of graduating domestic students accepted employment offers at the company where they interned.

A first-year total salary of \$5,802,422 was reported by 71 domestic graduates. The average annual salary is \$81,725 with a range of \$56,000 - \$100,000. The median salary was \$82,500. Ninety-one percent of eligible domestic candidates were placed.

Student Profile

For 2021-22 LER had 187 MHRIR on-campus students from 66 undergraduate institutions (44 domestic and 22 international), 53 majors, 13 states and seven countries.

The class was 73% female, 46.4% minority (25.6% African American, Hispanic/Latino, American Indian; 20.8% Asian American). The class is 22% international. Thirty-four percent have at least one year of work experience and then average age is 24.

Internships

Internships provide real-world experience to supplement classroom learning and allow employers to develop mentor relationships with current students. Managers can also measure their potential as a full-time employee and prepare them for success after graduation.

This summer, 66 domestic students reported earning a total of \$1,060,910.
